**A Review of TubeQuizard.com**

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**Abstract**

This article reviews a web-based educational tool named TubeQuizard, which allows users to create interactive listening quizzes based on YouTube subtitled videos. The platform offers pre-made quizzes with a wide range of topics, levels, and language points. Besides that, TubeQuizard allows EFL teachers and learners to choose videos beyond its collection and modify quizzes to suit their purposes. Therefore, it is beneficial for improving listening skills and other components of language, such as grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and spelling. It is worth noting that educators can use TubeQuizard to design tasks for both teaching and assessment progress. The website also aids students in self-learning activities to enhance their language competency. Along with its significant advantages, TubeQuizard has some minor drawbacks that could be improved.

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In recent years, multimedia technology has played a significant role in the progress of teaching and learning languages, especially English. Xiao-Pand and Khapre (2021) say that it has changed the traditional teacher-centered teaching scheme and enhanced the quality of the information being delivered. Furthermore, by virtue of media technology, English language instructors now have access to additional resources and opportunities to teach their students effectively (Gerstein, 2014).

Regarding online resources, YouTube has been recognized as one of the most effective media platforms for teachers in English classrooms (Fay & Matias, 2019). The platform provides users free access to a wide range of videos with various topics and levels. Therefore, YouTube is useful for English learners of different ages and language abilities. There is evidence that YouTube has improved language competencies of English learners. Results from a study conducted by Watkins and Wilkins (2011) show that the website contributes positively to the development of four fundamental English skills: listening, reading, speaking, and writing. In addition, Nasution (2019) suggests that exposure to World Englishes through videos on YouTube can help students develop their authentic vocabulary, while Nofrika (2019) argues that YouTube can also enhance English grammar.

There are various ways to exploit YouTube in teaching and learning English. One tool that can support the usage of YouTube is the website TubeQuizard.com. It allows English teachers to generate interactive quizzes based on subtitled YouTube videos. This article aims to give an overview of TubeQuizard – a tool designed by two English educators, Olya Sergeeva and Kirill Sukhomlin, and a reflection on its use with non-English major students at Van Lang University.

### **A General Description**

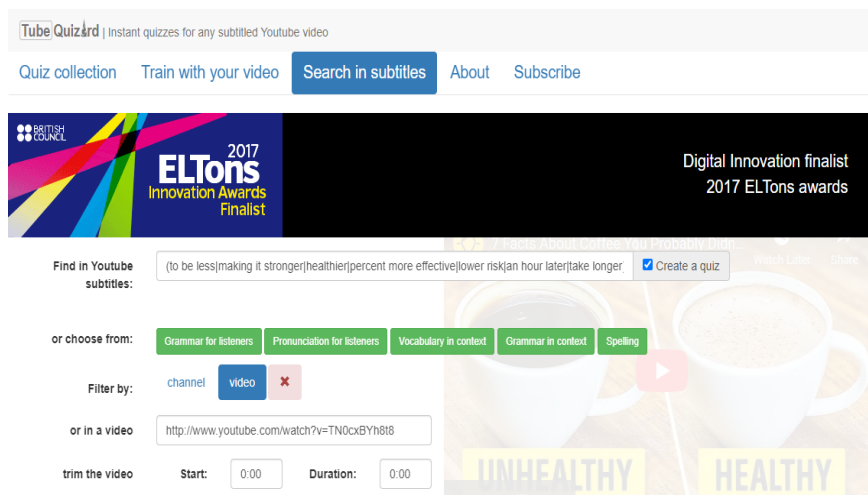

Teachers and students who may be unable to access other resources because of financial constraints or other obstacles will find this feature particularly beneficial. As such, TubeQuizard offers everyone the same chance to access language learning tools.

In addition to its accessibility, TubeQuizard is appreciated for its capability to fit different language levels. Learners can improve their grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and spelling at their own pace by taking quizzes ranging from A2 to C2 levels. Moreover, TubeQuizard offers a wide range of topics that correspond to the students' interests. EFL

teachers who desire to design engaging lessons that are suited to their students' needs will find this function especially valuable. ### **Weaknesses**

While the website TubeQuizard has a host of useful features, it also has several shortcomings that limit its effectiveness as a language learning tool.

One major shortcoming of TubeQuizard is that it provides only a certain number of videos with subtitles. If teachers want to explore videos with different accents or topics, they have to use to search for videos on Youtube outside the pre-selected videos. However, only those with high-quality subtitles are accepted. Hence, it is difficult for educators to customize quizzes from specific videos or topics that they want to focus on.

In addition, TubeQuizard provides only sentence completion exercises. This type of exercise is beneficial for developing specific skills, such as listening for specific words or phrases. However, sentence completion exercises are a passive form of learning in which learners merely select the correct options without actively engaging with the language or improving their own production skills. Therefore, learners might not have opportunities to develop independent language skills or the ability to use language creatively. What is more, using the same type of exercise repeatedly can be tedious and lead to boredom and monotony, especially for learners who prefer more interactive and engaging activities. Apart from that, sentence completion exercises often only require a simple answer, which can make it difficult for learners to receive detailed feedback on their listening skills. Without detailed feedback, learners may not know where they need to improve or how to develop their listening skills further.

## Reflection

We incorporated TubeQuizard into the pronunciation, grammar, listening and vocabulary lessons for eight classes in the A2 level at Van Lang University, and it has proven to be a successful approach to teaching English language skills. The teacher-designed lessons have allowed for the incorporation of TubeQuizard in a way that has complemented the overall lesson plan and learning outcomes. Utilizing TubeQuizard in the pronunciation and listening classes has allowed students to learn in an entertaining way. Incorporating TubeQuizard into the vocabulary and grammar lessons has enabled students to learn new words and syntax structures enjoyably. The students' positive attitude and interest towards using TubeQuizard after 10 weeks are signs of the website's success. The website has provided a platform for students to learn English in an engaging and motivating way. The improved results in the students' English skills after using TubeQuizard are further proof of the website's effectiveness. The student's pronunciation skills and listening abilities have been enhanced by using the website's features and receiving feedback. Furthermore, the students have acquired and memorized new words and essential grammatical points through the numerous quizzes available. The website has developed an enjoyable and interactive way for students to learn English, helping them remember what they have studied.
